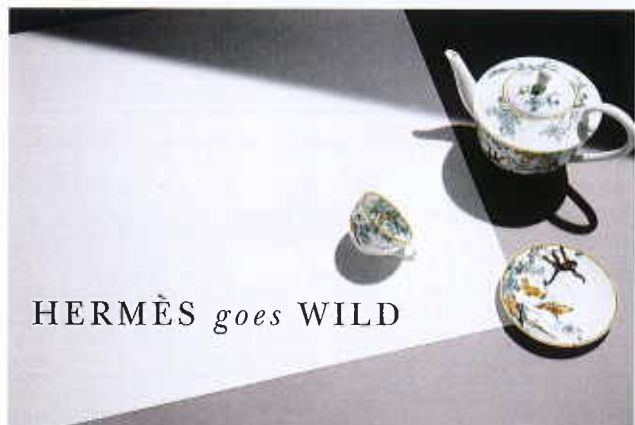

So far HERMÈS has only manufactured scarves and fabrics with exotic flora and fauna by famous artist and naturalist ROBERT DALLET. The artist worked with Hermès from 1984, and when he died in 2006 the fashion company bought his enormous archive of natural motives. On the new dinner set *Carnets d'Equateur* Dallet's wild animals have been transposed onto china, so that jaguars now pose on dinner plates, monkeys hang from vines along the edges of bowls, and parrots adorn the outside of teacups. We love this set, which is like going on a virtual safari through a tropical landscape.



MAGIC TOUCH

Brass and mouth-blown glass are some of the hottest materials at the moment. New French design studio MAGIC CIRCUS EDITIONS create lamps of these.
