The 'Y Lamp' was designed by Noé Duchaufour-Lawrance for Maison Intègre, whose foundry in Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso, produced this piece. The Portugal-based French designer was inspired by the Lobi ladder, an everyday domestic object used in West Africa to access the roof where cereals are dried.

Transformed in scale and rendered in polished bronze, Duchaufour-Lawrance's light becomes a totemic sacred item and moves inside the home, imbued with a new function and importance.
